- By Monday, February 26th **intern candidates** will be notified if they have been selected to attend the “speed-interview” round and be provided descriptions of the internships
- “Speed Interview” for **companies and intern candidates** will take place on Friday, March 2nd from 3:00pm-6:30pm at CFC Office, 122 E. Chatham St, Cary, NC.
- By Tuesday, March 6th at 5pm **intern candidates** will provide an ordered list of the top 10 companies they would like to intern with
- By Tuesday March 6th at 5pm **companies** will provide a list of the top 10 intern candidates they would like to have work for them.
- By Thursday March 8th, interns will be notified if they have been matched with a company based on mutual interest*
